Components of TMS Suzuki Program

Private Lessons

Private lessons occur once a week and are individually scheduled with the instructor. Lesson length starts at 30 minutes and, as the student progresses, may extend to 45 or 60 minutes. Parents are required to attend all lessons with their child(ren).

Group Classes

Tuesdays are Suzuki days at The Music Settlement! Suzuki students participate in group classes that occur **bi-weekly on Tuesday evenings**.

- **Musicianship:** A new student's first group class is Musicianship, a 30-minute non-instrument specific class which covers basic music concepts such as focus, steady beat, rhythm, and singing.
- **Instrumental Group Class:** These classes reinforce skills learned in their private lessons, teach students ensemble playing skills, and provide camaraderie and social interaction.
- **Theory Class:** Music theory classes help reinforce note reading and theoretical skills. Our theory curriculum includes Dalcroze Eurhythmics: a holistic approach to music theory, teaching musical concepts through movement.
